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Notes: -

1. Please notify us if you change your name or address while the declaration is in force
2. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying us - it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay sufficient tax on your income (or capital gains tax), you must advise us to cancel your declaration. Gift Aid is linked to basic rate tax. Basic rate tax is currently 20%, which currently allows charities to reclaim 25 pence on the pound.
4. Higher rate taxpayers can claim back the difference between basic rate and higher rate or additional rate tax. If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.

Gift Aid

If you pay income tax, then you can Gift Aid your gifts at no cost to you. Gift Aid means that the Church can reclaim the tax you have already paid on your gifts i.e. for every £1 given, the church can reclaim another 25p, so the church actually gets £1.25. All you need to do is complete the one-off declaration on page 2.

Stoughton PCC General Funds

What is the money used for?

We have to cover:-

- the **running costs** of the Church such as heating, lighting, water, telephone insurance etc.
- the '**Parish Share**' which pays clergy stipends & a contribution to the Diocese
- the **salaries** of our Administrators, Children's and Youth Workers.

We also look to do the following:-

- undertake **Pastoral and Evangelistic work (including Youth Work)**.
- give to **other Christian projects etc.**
- keep our **buildings** clean & in good repair and our **equipment** up to date.

Where does the money come from?

The Church's income only comes from two sources:

- **direct giving** from members of the congregation
- **hire charges** for the use of the church's facilities.
